



Frank Hanson

May 14, 1960 - January 7, 2017

The memorial service for Frank Hanson of Eagle Bend will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 3, at the Faith Lutheran Church in Eagle Bend, with Pastor Ned Lenhart presiding. Visitation will be held at the church on Saturday one hour prior to the time of the service.

Frank passed away unexpectedly at the age of 56, on January 7, 2017, at Lakewood Health System, Staples, MN.

Frank was born to Gerard and Margaret (Dahl) Hanson on May 14, 1960 in Sacramento, CA, where he lived until the age of eleven. He was baptized in Sacramento and confirmed at Faith Lutheran in Eagle Bend, MN. From an early age, Frank was always involved in sports, including Little League and he learned how to golf and fish from his dad. He picked up an interest in guitar playing during his high school years.

Frank's love of fishing and golfing continued his entire life. He loved being in the woods, whether 4-wheeling, woodcutting, or deer hunting with his buddies. He and his friends spent many hours around a bonfire. Frank put in a big garden in the summer, later canning his own tomato juice. Pets were important companions, especially the Labrador Retrievers he had most of his life. Frank also loved to feed and watch birds throughout the summer.

After college, Frank headed to California to find employment and returned to Eagle Bend a few years later. He worked for Sterns Rubber Company, on a road construction crew, and did general labor on local farms. Until 2015 he was employed at Dan's Prize in Browerville.

Frank was preceded in death by his parents Gerard and Margaret. He is survived by his sister Linda (Mathew Chrystal) Hanson of South Bend, IN; aunt Violet Sumey of Fairmont; along with many cousins.
