Agnes L. Dague was born on January 16, 1920 to Adrian and Luella (Routier) Svenson in Chamberlain, SD. She passed away, at the age of 89, at home in rural Verndale, on Thursday, April 16, 2009. Agnes was united in marriage with Willard Dague on January 16, 1939 at her parent's home in Chamberlain. Agnes was a homemaker while Willard farmed in South Dakota until 1953 when they moved to Poplar, MN and later to Verndale in 1961 when she worked in the Wadena Butter Plant.
