Agnes Noreen Theidich Leeseberg, age 84, passed away on April 1st surrounded by her children at the Knute Nelson Memorial Home in Alexandria. Agnes was born on July 30, 1921 in Alexandria the daughter of Mabel (Sangren) and Carl Theidich. The family moved to Henning where Agnes grew up, met and married Lawrence Wendell Leeseberg in 1938.
