The funeral service for Agnes Wahner of Wadena will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Friday, January 22, at the Johnson-Schuller Chapel in Wadena, with Father Aaron Kuhn as celebrant. Visitation will be held at the Chapel on Friday from 12:30 p.m. until the time of service. Just shy of her 94th birthday, Agnes passed away on Sunday, January 17, 2016, at the Lakewood Health System Care Center in Staples, MN.

Agnes Elizabeth (Uselman) Wahner was born to Wolfgang “Wilfred” and Clara (Kelzer) Uselman on January 21, 1922, in Wadena, MN.

Agnes was united in marriage with Harold “Dutch” John Wahner on May 6, 1944, in Wadena. They farmed southwest of Hewitt until retirement and then moved back to Agnes’ hometown of Wadena. Agnes took great pride in caring for their yard, home, and her beautiful flower gardens. She also enjoyed baking.

Agnes was preceded in death by her husband Dutch on April 12, 1993; parents Wilfred and Clara; three brothers; five sisters; and one infant sister.

She is survived by her daughters Janice (George) Rinde of Badger and Debby (Philip) Jasmer of Aldrich; three granddaughters and five great-grandchildren; four step-grandchildren and nine step-great-grandchildren; along with her

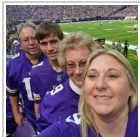

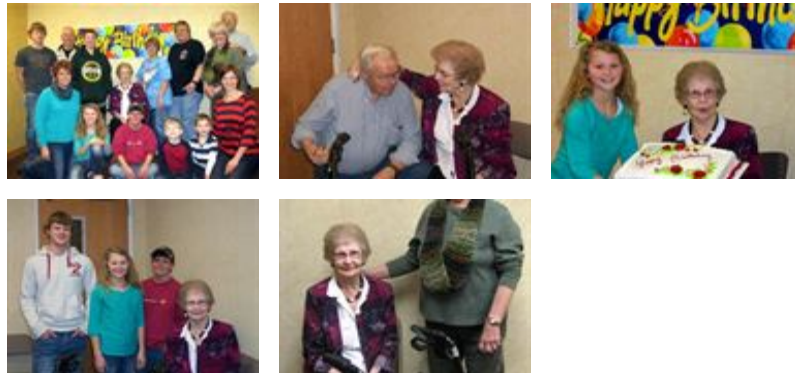
