Algot Harold Martinson, of Wadena and formerly of Compton Township, was born on Oct. 14, 1903 to Martin and Carrie (Peterson) Martinson in Deer Creek Township. Algot passed away on Mar. 21, 2005 at Tri-County Hospital in Wadena at the age of 101 years. Algot married Ellen Loween on Mar. 24, 1940 at the Compton Lutheran Church. Algot was a lifetime member of the area and farmed until his retirement in 1974. He served as a board member of the Compton Lutheran Church and Compton School, and was more recently a member of Messiah Lutheran Church.
