The funeral service for Alice Hallett of rural Verndale was held at 10:30 a.m. on Wednesday, August 15, 2012, at the Johnson Memorial Home Chapel in Verndale, with Pastor Daryl Jacobson presiding. Surrounded by family, Alice passed away at her home in rural Verndale, on August 11, 2012, at the age of 70 years, under the care of Lakewood Hospice. Alice Mae Hallett was born to Albert B. and Alice O. (Haugen) Kasper on December 17, 1941 in Orange Township, Adams County, ND. She attended high school in Sebeka, MN. Alice married Lloyd "Barney" William Hallett on October 23, 1959, at St. Frederick's Catholic Church in Verndale.
