Allen Howard Fultz was born on the family farm in Leaf River Township on January 10, 1937 to his parents Howard & Ethel (Erickson) Fultz. Al passed away early on Monday, February 13th at the Tri-County Hospital in Wadena. Al served many churches in the area as their pastor. He also worked for a number of years at Wadena-Deer Creek schools. Recently he has served as board chairman at SonRise Christian School in rural Bluffton. He was also very active in the community. He was a member of the Wadena Ministerial Assoc., England Prairie Pioneer Club, Silver Spur Saddle Club and the Minnesota Assoc. of School Maintenance Supervisors. Al and Helen will always be remembered for their music with the Grand Ol Gospel. Al has spent most of his life in the Wadena area. He loved to fish, hunt, farm, telling good stories and jokes, pickin' and grinnin', and making music for the Lord. Al was united in marriage to Helen Mae Goedel on October 26, 1957 in the Christian & Missionary Alliance Church in Wadena. Al was preceded in death by his parents. He is survived by his loving wife Helen; sons Tim (Sandy) of Sebeka and Travis (Melissa) of Ft. Polk, LA; daughters Kayleen (Jim) Meyer of Hillsboro, OR, Mandy (Mike) Sharp of Hillsboro, OR, Connie Fultz of Wadena and Monica Jane Heyer of Brainerd; 14 grandchildren; sisters Lois Benson of Anoka, Wanda Fultz of Wadena and Debbie Auguston of Maple Grove. Funeral services will be held on Wed. February 15th at 2:00 PM in the Christian & Missionary Alliance Church in Verndale with Rev. Daryl Jacobson and Rev. Russell Benson officiating.
