June 9, 1922 - April 7, 2009

Andrew John Schmith of Aldrich, was born on June 9, 1922 to Nicholas and Emma (Geber) Schmith in Wadena, MN. He passed away, unexpectedly, on April 7, 2009 at the family farm in Verndale at the age of 86 years. Andy served as a sergeant in the United States Army from November 1942 to December 1945. He was united in marriage with Elsie McDowell on June 2, 1948, and their marriage lasted until her death in October 1978. He later married Ardy Nelson on June 5, 1987. Other than his time in the service, and 3 years in South Dakota, Andy lived his entire life in the Wadena, Verndale and Aldrich communities. Andy will be remembered as a manager for 35 years at the West Central Telephone Association. He belonged to the Aldrich Lions Club and the Verndale American Legion. In his spare time he enjoyed farming, gardening, hunting, fishing, and traveling. Andy was preceded in death by his first wife, Elsie; parents, Nicholas and Emma; and sisters Marcy Lubke and MaryAnn Nelson. He is survived by his wife Ardy of Aldrich; sons, Tom of Verndale, David of Las Vegas, NV, Dick of Brooklyn Park, and Dale of Verndale; daughters, Kathy (Will) Dague of Anoka, and Karen (Mark) Maronde of Falcon Heights; 6 grandchildren and 5 great-grandchildren; brothers, Bud (Marion) Schmith of Wadena, and Mannie (Pat) Schmith of Brainerd; sisters, Beaty Larson of Wadena, and Betty (Clyde) Bigelow of Sioux Falls, SD; Ardy's daughters, LuJean (Steve) Larson of Minneapolis, and Jackie (Chuck) Anderson of Monticello; 7 grandchildren and 4 great-grandchildren. The Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated at 11:00 AM on Monday, April 13, 2009 at

St. Frederick's Catholic Church in Verndale with Father Michael Kellogg as celebrant.
