



## Anthony "Tony" Roggenkamp

August 23, 1925 - April 13, 2013

The Mass of Christian Burial for Anthony "Tony" Frank Roggenkamp of Bluffton, will be celebrated at 11:00 AM on Friday, April 19, 2013 at St. John the Baptist Catholic Church in Bluffton with Father Donald Wagner as celebrant. Visitation will continue on Friday at the church from 9:30 AM until the time of mass. Tony passed away at the age of 87 years on Saturday, April 13, 2013 at the Fair Oaks Lodge in Wadena.

Tony was born on August 23, 1925 at Bluffton, MN to Henry and Bernadine (Schmiesing) Roggenkamp. He was raised on a farm and attended school in Bluffton. He served his country in the US Army. He was united in marriage with Margaret "Muggs" Mary Wynn on May 17, 1948 at St. John the Baptist Catholic Church in Bluffton.

Tony spent his lifetime farming in Bluffton. After retiring, he lived in Wadena and Hewitt. He was a member of St. John the Baptist Catholic Church in Bluffton and St. Ann's Catholic Church in Wadena. He enjoyed being outdoors, deer hunting and spending time with Muggs and their family.

Tony was preceded in death by his parents Henry and Bernadine; brothers Henry, Peter, Joseph, and Alphonse; sisters Regina, Rose, Flora, Leona and

Dorothy; and grandchildren Christina Roggenkamp, Jacob Roggenkamp, Mark Roggenkamp and Joseph Sampson.
