Ardelle Marie Buchanan was born February 6, 1933 in Oak Valley Township, Otter Tail County, Minnesota. She passed away on March 8, 2008 at Eldercare Center, N.E. Minneapolis. She was preceded in death by parents, Dell and Clara (Roeske) Buchanan and her brothers, Dean (Lucille) and Gary Buchanan.
