April 19, 1922 - September 14, 2012

The funeral service for Bertha Scofield of Wadena was held at 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 18, 2012 at the St. John Lutheran Church in Wadena, with Pastor Stephen Meltzer officiating. Bertha passed away at her daughter's home in Wadena, on Friday, September 14, 2012, at the age of 90 years, under the care of Lakewood Hospice of Staples. Bertha C. Scofield was born April 19, 1922 to William and Ida (Jacob) Dorn in Sebeka, MN. She was united in marriage with Harry A. Scofield on October 10, 1939 in Sebeka. They farmed near Hewitt. She worked on the farm and was employed at Peterson-Biddick in Wadena, and did general labor and sewing at Homecrest, Ind. in Wadena, as well as at Ringers Mfg. in Staples. Bertha was a member of the LWML at St. John Lutheran Church in Wadena. She provided many hours as a volunteer during school and over the summer months at Kid's Club and as a Foster Grandparent at WDC Schools. She served as a homecare assistant at Little Bit O' Country, and most recently, as a Senior Companion. She liked to spend time fishing, gardening, crocheting, and enjoyed a bit of gambling, too. Bertha was preceded in death by her husband Harry, on December 1, 1981; parents William and Ida; brothers and their wives William & Bernie Dorn and Leon & Devona Dorn; a sister Vivian Bragg; brother-in-law Eldon Nohrenberg; son-in-law Gordon Schlichting; and granddaughters Kriste Kay Schlichting Kircher and Kerry Lynn Schlichting Brandvold. She is survived by her son Allen (Linda) Scofield of Alexandria and daughter Luella "Lu" Schlichting of Wadena; five grandchildren & four great-grandchildren;
