June 3, 1926 - September 28, 2007

Bruce Howard Nelson passed away quietly at his home on Friday, September 28th. Bruce was born to his parents Elmer A. & Mabel (Ellison) Nelson on June 3, 1926 in Clarissa. Bruce was a lifelong member of the Wadena community. He owned and operated Wadena Implement for many years. On Oct. 6, 1947 he was united in marriage to Mary Ann Schmith at St. Ann's Catholic Church in Wadena. Both he and his wife were very active members of the community. Bruce was a member of the Wadena Lions Club, where he served as a past president and a Melvin Jones Fellow, the Wadena Elks Lodge and the Wadena VFW where he served as post commander. He was also active in politics and served as mayor of Wadena for many years. Bruce served his country in the US Army from Nov. 13, 1944 to Nov. 11, 1946. In his spare time he enjoyed volunteering, woodworking and spending time with his family. Bruce was preceded in death by his beloved wife, Mary Ann on Mar. 2, 2003; his parents; 6 brothers and 2 sisters. He is survived by his daughters: Connie (Mike) Kelley and Marilyn Morgan both of Minneapolis, Shirley (Geoff) Williams of Brainerd and Judy Spahn of Burnsville; sons Steve (Janice) of Blanche Lake, Scott of Woodbury, Wayne and David (Janet) both of Edina; 20 grandchildren and 5 great-grandchildren. The Mass of Christian Burial will be held on Monday, Oct. 1st at 11:00 AM in the St. Ann's Catholic Church in Wadena with Fr. Donald Wagner as celebrant. Honorary pallbearers will be Dudes Richter, Jim Logan and all of the Boondocks Cafe coffee gang. Active pallbearers will be his children; Steve, Connie, Marilyn, Scott, Shirley, Judy,
