Carl S. Williams was born to Albert and Jennie (Nuland) Williams on May 10, 1904 in Eagle Bend, Minnesota. Carl was a life long resident of the Eagle Bend area. He grew to manhood on a small farm in Wykeham Township. Carl was a man of many talents. He was a trapper, carpenter, bricklayer and veteran of WWII. Carl belonged to the American Legion for 55 years. He also sold honey and produce to the local grocery store. Carl's hobbies were deer hunting, fishing, visiting family and friends, playing card, delivering meals-on-wheels and gardening. Carl died on January 18, 2005 at the Lakewood Systems Hospital in Staples at the age of 100 years and 8 months.
