



Carol Hahn

March 11, 1937 - April 9, 2017

The funeral service for Carol Hahn, of Perham will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 15, at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Perham with Reverend Carl Noble presiding. Visitation will be held at the church on Saturday from 12:30 p.m. until the time of service. Carol, age 80, passed away on Sunday, April 9, 2017, at her daughter's home from complications related to dementia. In hospice care for six weeks, she died peacefully surrounded by her children and two grandchildren.

Carol was born to Erwin Thomas and Signe Alvira (Louhela) Forcier on March 11, 1937 in Cloquet, MN. She grew up in Little Falls and married Dennis Hahn on March 14, 1960, in Brookings, SD. They moved to Minneapolis where their daughter Linda was born. The family moved to Wadena, Sandy's birthplace, and then to Little Falls where Brenda and Theresa were born. Bradley and Jeffrey were born in Brainerd when the family lived near Camp Ripley. Carol and Dennis farmed for 21 years before they parted ways. Carol did factory work, including at Tuffy's and Barrel O' Fun, as well as working at a dry cleaners and cleaned motel rooms to support herself and the children until her retirement in 2002.

Carol was busy with her family and enjoyed pastimes such as reading, gardening and crossword puzzles. She was an avid TV viewer of westerns, with Bonanza and The Rifleman as her favorites. Most of all, she loved getting

together with her family and never wanted those hours to end. Carol wasn't one to talk a lot, but closely observed and knew everything that was happening. Though she used few words, they were always straightforward so you knew where she stood on the subject. Often she weighed in on things with her beautiful smile if she approved, or "the look" if she disapproved. Carol always did the best with what she had and was a beautiful person, inside and out.

Carol was preceded in death by son Bradley; granddaughter Maria; parents Erwin and Signe; brothers Tom and Jack; and sisters Grace and Joyce; step-mother Rhea Forcier.

She is survived by her daughters Linda (Harvey) McGrane of Hewitt, Sandra (Roger) Allen of Braham, Brenda Romig of Brainerd and Theresa (Marc) Cregan of Oak Grove; son Jeff Hahn of Wadena; 26 grandchildren and 54 great-grandchildren; brother Jim (Joan) Forcier of Cherokee, IA; step-brothers Murray and Leroy Forcier; step-sister Dianna Bergquist; several nieces and nephews; along with her special friend David Meyer of Perham.

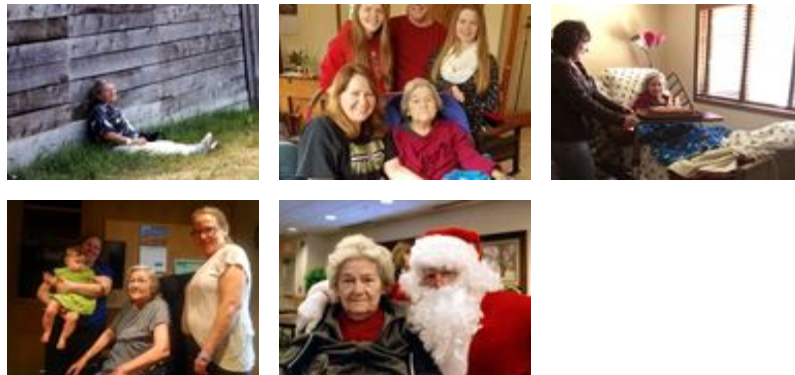

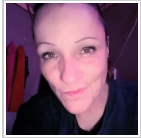
