June 20, 1916 - December 7, 2007

Cecilia A. Buettner, age 91, of Bluffton, passed-away December 7, 2007, at Perham Memorial Hospital. She was born to Lorenz and Theresia (Jeno) Stoderl on June 20, 1916 in rural Bluffton. Cecilia was united in marriage to Alfred Buettner, by Father N. P. Junker, on June 6, 1939 at St. John's Catholic Church in Bluffton. She lived her entire life in the Bluffton community and was a member of the Christian Mothers Society and St. Mary's Mission Circle. She enjoyed gardening, sewing, knitting, quilting, making cancer pads for the missions, and eating at her favorite restaurants.
