October 14, 1917 - February 25, 2006

Clarence Martinson, age 88 of Eagle Bend, passed away on Saturday, February 25, 2006 at the Central Todd County Care Center in Clarissa. Funeral services were held at 11:00 AM on Tuesday at the Faith Lutheran Church in Eagle Bend with Reverend Cordell Strug and Reverend Mary Carol Strug presiding. Clarence Walter Martinson was born on October 14, 1917 at Eagle Bend to Edward and Greta (Oftedahl) Martinson. He attended country schools and worked on his parents farm. Clarence was a lifelong resident of the Eagle Bend area, operating a farm until 1995 when, due to health reasons, he sold the farm and moved to his apartment in Bertha. In 2002 he moved to the Care Center in Clarissa. When possible, he enjoyed sitting and watching a baseball game on TV. He also was a successful bounty hunter as one summer he was recognized in the newspaper at having trapped over 600 pocket gophers. Clarence was preceded in death by his parents, Edward and Greta; brothers Elmer, Arnold and Kenneth; and sisters Alice Scott, Gladys Oliver, Mable Haukland and Irene Oliver. He is survived by his sister Helen Peterson of Roseville, MN and many nieces and nephews. Pallbearers were Woodrow Peery, Kevin Ehnes, Dave Meierding, John Eckel, Allen Skoglund and Jack Johnson.
