



## Clifford Greenwood Jr.

August 9, 1938 - October 18, 2020

The funeral service for Clifford Greenwood, Jr of Bertha, will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Friday, October 23 at the United Methodist Church in Wrightstown, with Pastor Mark Bateson presiding.

Visitation with family and friends will be held at the Domian-Anderson Chapel in Bertha on Thursday from 6:00 until 8:00 p.m. and will resume at the church on Friday from 12:30 p.m. until the time of the service.

Clifford, age 82, passed away of natural causes while doing something he loved, deer hunting, on October 18, 2020, in rural Bertha, MN.

Clifford Ellis Greenwood, Jr was born to Clifford and Gladys (Sibert) Greenwood on August 9, 1938, in Bertha, MN. Cliff graduated from high school and was a natural mechanic. He spent many hours working on small engines and was an avid outdoorsman who looked forward to time spent with family and friends while hunting and fishing. He often found bargains at auctions and garage sales, and was an armchair coach for the Twins baseball and Vikings football games.

Preceding Cliff in death were his parents Cliff, Sr and Gladys; daughter Vickie Lee Ness; siblings Betty Blegen, Barb Fisher, Violet "Vi" Hennagir and Darlene Klemek.

Cliff will be remembered by his children Debbie (Randy) Robb of Osakis, Steve Greenwood of Alexandria, Brad Greenwood of Willmar, Ryan (Ashley) Greenwood of Eagle Bend, Corey (Melissa) Eckel of Motley, Michelle (JR) Blumer of Clarissa and Nicholas (Jeff) VerSteeg of Texas; 18 grandchildren, and 21 great-grandchildren; along with brother-in-law Larry Klemek of Eagle Bend; and many nieces and nephews.
