Memorial services for Craig Anderson of Brooklyn Park, MN were held at 2:00PM on Friday, August 22, 2008 at the St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Bertha with Reverend Blake Rickbeil presiding. Craig passed away as a result of an accident at his home in Brooklyn Park on Saturday, August 16, 2008 at the age of 49 years. Craig John Anderson was born on May 18, 1959 at the Theil Hospital in Bertha to Arvid A. and Margaret L. (Gaines) Anderson. He graduated from Bertha-Hewitt High School and Alexandria Technical College in Alexandria, MN. He then moved to Minneapolis and worked for Honeywell in commercial and military avionics. He enjoyed fishing and being outdoors, aviation and traveling. Craig was preceded in death by his father Arvid A. Anderson. He is survived by his mother Margaret L. Anderson of Bertha; brothers Kevin Anderson of Ridgeway, MO and Curtis (Connie) Anderson of Coon Rapids, MN; sister Mellisa (Chad) Hurtig of Bertha; nieces and nephew Tara Anderson, Kayla Anderson and T.J. Noll; and aunts, uncles and cousins. He is also survived by his special friends Ginny and Dave Enfield. Interment was in the Zoar Cemetery located in Germania Township, MN.
