Services are pending for Craig Stephen Redford, age 50 of Thief River Falls, MN. Craig died on Friday, November 7, 2025, from complications related to a brain tumor, at the Fair Oaks Lodge in Wadena, MN under the gentle care of the staff at the nursing home and St. Croix Hospice.

Craig was born to Paul and Shirley (Diedrick) Redford on February 9, 1975, in Mankato, MN. He grew up in St. Clair where he attended school and received his GED. His interests included fishing, hunting and traveling, including going to New York, California and Florida. He was a lifelong gamer who also enjoyed Frisbee golf and 10,000/Farkle.

A man of few words, his family and friends found him to be humble and someone who always had something funny to say. His pets were a big part of his life, especially his dog, Max. Craig loved his family and would do anything to help someone.

On September 10, 1999, Craig was united in marriage with Rebecca McCarthy. They lived in Eagle Lake, where Craig worked for LeSueur Inc for several years. Sadly, Rebecca passed away on July 15, 2004.
