August 3, 1925 - June 2, 2008

A Service of Thanksgiving in memory of David W. Anderson, a life-long resident of Eagle Bend, was held at 1:00 PM on Saturday, June 7, 2008 at the Faith Lutheran Church in Eagle Bend with Reverend Cordell Strug and Reverend Mary Carol Strug presiding. The organist was John Ferguson of St. Olaf College in Northfield, MN. David passed away on Monday, June 2, 2008 in his home of his birth at the age of 82 years and 10 months. David Wesley Anderson was born on August 3, 1925 to Albert D. and Marie (Hofstad) Anderson at their home in Wykeham Township, Todd County. He graduated from Eagle Bend High School and then ran the family dairy farm until retirement. He was united in marriage with Barbara Ruth Lehman at Slater, IA on May 31, 1952. David served his community as a member of Faith Lutheran Church, the Todd County Historical Society, Eagle Bend Historical Society and the Hope Cemetery Board. He enjoyed genealogy, history, reading and debating historical and current events. David was preceded in death by his parents Albert and Marie; and sisters Marian Dietz and Illys Anderson. He is survived by Ruth, his wife of 56 years; daughters Barbara Anderson of Tucson, AZ, Jane Anderson and Pamela Anderson, both of Lexington, KY; five grandchildren; and sister Lois Seifert of Moorhead, MN.
