November 9, 1963 - September 26, 2011

Funeral services for David John Rausch of rural Eagle Bend were held at 2:00 PM on Thursday, September 29, 2011 at the First Baptist Church in Parkers Prairie with Pastor Robert Deugan presiding. David passed away unexpectedly on Monday, September 26, 2011 at the Tri County Hospital in Wadena at the age of 47 years. David was born on November 9, 1963 to John and Erna (Haase) Rausch in the Browerville Hospital. He graduated from Bertha-Hewitt High School in 1982. He was united in marriage with Michele Benson at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Bertha on September 21, 1985. Together they lived in Wadena for a year before purchasing and moving to the Rausch family farm in 1986. David worked at Homecrest Industries for 23 years and then returned to school for diesel mechanics at Central Lakes College in Staples.
