



## Dean Warren

July 24, 1936 - February 19, 2017

The funeral service for Dean Warren of Wadena will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, February 25, at the Zion Free Lutheran Church in Wadena, with Pastor Curt Emerson presiding. Visitation will be held on Friday from 5:00 until 7:00 p.m. at the Johnson-Schuller Chapel in Wadena, and will resume at the church on Saturday from 9:30 a.m. until the time of service.

With family at his side, Dean passed away at the age of 80, on February 19, 2017 at the Lakewood Health System Care Center, Staples, MN.

Dean Rosevelt Warren was born to LeRoy and Gladys (Ferguson) Warren on July 24, 1936 in Cashel Township, Swift County, MN. During his childhood he lived in Benson, MN and Spencer, IA. He moved back to Minnesota and resided in Wadena since 1979.

Dean was united in marriage with Judith "Judy" Ann Erickson on June 7, 1986, at the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Wadena, MN. He worked as a custodian until his retirement. Hours away from work found him outdoors enjoying fishing, working on cars, and perfecting his lawn.

Dean was preceded in death by his parents LeRoy and Gladys; brothers Donald, James, Raymond and Clifford Warren; sister Myrtle Lau; and Betty Sutton.
