



Dennis Ahrens

January 24, 1944 - January 29, 2012

Dennis Wayne Ahrens was the fourth living child and second son of Henry Charles and Carmelleta May (Lytle) Ahrens. He was born outside of Brainerd in Crow Wing County in their home on January 24, 1944. He had three older sisters, Donna Mae, Florine Fae (known as Rene), and Pat. Dennis attended school in Brainerd, Motley and Staples. The family moved to Staples when he was 12 years old. He remained a member of the Staples community for over 50 years. While he was still in high school he joined the National Guard in 1961 and was a member of the Guard until 1967. He was a car man for the railroad and retired after 31 years of dedicated work. Dennis and Carolin Charie Gould were married on October 27, 1962. He died at home on January 29, 2012, at the age of 68. Carolin and Dennis raised two children, Curt and Shawn, who reside in St. Cloud with their families; they have three grandchildren, Shelby, Cody, and Ava who have brought so much enjoyment to their life. Dennis' interests were golfing, hunting, motorcycling, visiting car shows, and his family, which included his wildlife family in his backyard. Dennis is survived by his wife of 49 years Carolin; son Curt and his wife Carrie and their daughter Ava; daughter Shawn and fiancé Mike Mellies, Shawn's children Shelby and Cody, and Mike's children Samantha and Shawn; sisters Donna May Brobst Estherville, IA, and Pat (Tom) Neznik of Staples; many nieces and nephews from the Ahrens family, who thought of Dennis more of a father figure than just an uncle; Carolin's mother Beatrice Gould; the Gould brothers, Allen (Maureen), David (Sandra), Bruce (Lois), and Gary (Sandy);

and many nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents Henry and Carmelleta; sister Florine; an infant brother Henry Charles, Jr "Sonny"; father-in-law Floyd Gould; and brother-in-law Don Brobst. Memorial services were held at 2:00 p.m. on February 3, 2012 at the Johnson Memorial Home Chapel in Wadena, with Pastor Shirley Nelson presiding. Inurnment will be held this spring.
