Gerry, 88, passed away with family by her side on October 27, 2017 at the Elder's Home in New York Mills.

Gerry was born on June 13, 1929 the daughter of Thomas and Doris (Orton) Greear in Volin, SD. She was baptized and confirmed in the Volin Lutheran Church Parish. She graduated from Volin High School in 1947 and Minnesota School of Business in Minneapolis, MN in 1949. After graduating she was employed at Rapinwax Paper Company in Minneapolis, MN.

There she met her future husband, Laurel Lohse. They were united in marriage on March 24th, 1950 at the Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Minneapolis, MN. They lived in Minneapolis and New Brighton, raising their family of four children. She was a Sunday School teacher and a Cub Scout Den Mother. After moving to the Deer Creek area Gerry and Laurel started their business in 1972. After retiring, they moved to the Leader area. While in the Leader area, she was a member of the Leader Lions Club. Gerry was an avid reader and enjoyed word games and puzzles.

She is preceded in death by her husband, Laurel; parents, Thomas and Doris and brothers, Thomas and Preston.
