Dorothy Ann Berry, age 94, went home to be with her Lord, on Monday, December 12, 2011 at Fair Oaks Lodge in Wadena, MN. Dorothy was born August 25, 1917 in Boon Lake Township, Renville County, Minnesota, to Frank and Emelie (Walters) Bradford. She attended Dist. 25 country school, then graduated from Buffalo Lake High School in 1934. November 25, 1937 she married Sylvan Klucas in Hector, MN. They, and their four children, lived and farmed in this area and later the Eagle Bend and Bertha area. Dorothy married Donald Berry on September 18, 1977 in Lester Prairie.
