December 15, 1926 - April 23, 2006

Funeral services for Duane Hass, age 85 of Benson and formerly of Wadena and Clara City, were held at 11:00 AM on Wednesday (4/26/06) at the Johnson Memorial Home in Wadena with Reverend Larry Hager presiding.
