Funeral services for Eldon James Maland of rural Eagle Bend were held at 10:30 AM on Wednesday, January 18, 2012 at the Faith Lutheran Church in Eagle Bend with Pastor Melissa Ehrhardt presiding. Eldon passed away at the age of 72 years on Friday, January 13, 2012 at his home in Burleene Township. Eldon was born on November 30, 1939 to Miles and Velma (Conley) Maland at their home in Todd County. He graduated high school and began his service to his country when he enlisted in the US Navy on June 18, 1957. He was honorably discharged on October 28, 1960 and returned to Todd County. He was united in marriage with Betty Jane Wolf on April 21, 1962 in Eagle Bend. Eldon worked rockpicking and landscaping around the area. He enjoyed bowling and spending his time outdoors hunting, fishing and camping. He also loved spending time with all of his family and friends.
