Elizabeth Edith Erickson was born to John and Nellie (Anderson) Carlson on May 7, 1928, at Wadena, MN. After graduating from Wadena High School in 1946, she attended cosmetology school at Minneapolis, MN. She worked as a beauty salon owner, teacher's aide and home health aide.

Liz was united in marriage with Manley Glenn Erickson on June 7, 1953 at Sebeka, MN. She was a life-long member of the Lutheran church. At the

Messiah Lutheran Church in Wadena and Balsamlund Lutheran Church at Aldrich, MN, she participated as a church organist, pianist, and soprano in the church choir. She played trumpet in the Wadena City Band. She loved to travel, visiting Sweden, England, both the east and west coast of the US including Florida, Arizona, Colorado and Alaska. Liz was a life member and past president of the VFW Auxiliary in Wadena and an avid MN Twins baseball fan.

Preceding Liz in death were her husband Manley (April 22, 2003); parents John and Nellie; and sister Margaret Carlson Hanson.

She is survived by her children Connie (Tom) Fraser of The Woodlands, TX and Brian (Missy) Erickson of Royalton, MN; 5 grandchildren; and 5 great-grandchildren.

Interment will be in the Wadena Cemetery in Wadena, MN.

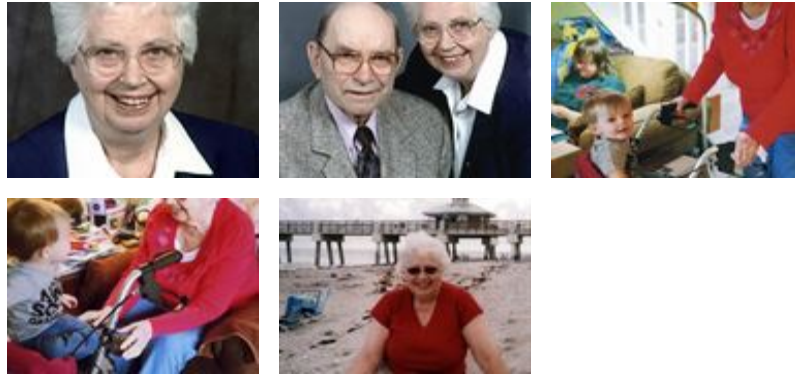

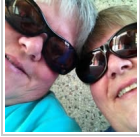
