September 1, 1917 - July 7, 2009

Erma Vera White, of Verndale, MN, was born September 1, 1917 to James E. and Margaret M. (Rappensparger) Crabtree in Tenstrike. She passed away on Tuesday, July 7, 2009, at age 91, at Lakewood Health System Hospital in Staples. Erma attended Quiring School in Beltrami County. She was united in marriage with Leonard E.
