July 1, 1923 - February 9, 2009

Funeral services for Ethel Pooler of Eagle Bend were held at 2:00 PM on Saturday, February 14, 2009 at the Faith Lutheran Church in Eagle Bend with Reverend Mary Carol Strug and Reverend Cordell Strug presiding. Ethel passed away on Monday, February 9, 2009 at the Redwood Area Hospital in Redwood Falls at the age of 85 years. Ethel Lucille Pooler was born on July 1, 1923 to Harry and Emma (Nelson) Clementson at their home in Wykeham Township. She graduated from Eagle Bend High School and on May 8, 1944, she was united in marriage with Wesley Albert Pooler in Long Prairie.
