Eugene Frederick Reger passed away at his home on Sunday evening at the age of 80. Gene was born to his parents Fred & Ann (Richter) Reger on August 4, 1926 in Wadena. After serving as a paratrooper in the US Army from from 1946 to 1947 he returned to Wadena and started Reger Sheet Metal and Heating, where he worked until his retirement. He was united in marriage to Inez L. Swanson on Nov. 14, 1949 in Wadena. He has been a life long resident of this area. Gene was very active in his community.
