September 8, 1934 - December 20, 2003

Eunice Theresa Moore was born to Guy and Letha (Flynn) Cunningham on Sept. 8, 1934 at Brocket, ND. She passed away peacefully early in the morning of December 20, 2003 at her home in Wadena. In the last moments of her long battle with cancer, she was surrounded and comforted by the family she cherished in life. In 1953, Eunice graduated from Devil's Lake High School in Devil's Lake, ND. In 1954, she married Vincent Duane Moore and the couple lived briefly in Fargo while Duane finished pharmacy school. Duane and Eunice welcomed their first child, Laurie, in 1955. Eunice was beloved by her family as an exceptional cook, a fount of amusing stories, and the driving force behind family gatherings. She always had time for a laugh and thrived on watching her grandchildren grow. She enjoyed reading, sewing, and spending summers at the family's lake cabin. Above all, Eunice loved bringing joy to her family. She thrilled in seeing her children laugh at the lake, delighted in the satisfied faces around her dinner table, and beamed when she presented her grandchildren with quilts. Her last days were spent at home in the presence

and prayers of her entire family. Eunice is preceded in death by her parents and brothers - Charles and Ray. She is survived by her husband of nearly fifty years - Duane; daughters - Laurie (Frank) Kohoutek of Plymouth and Maria (Howard) Clarys of Circle Pines; son - Thomas (Gail) of Fargo; grandchildren - Stephen, Christopher, Michael, Rachel, Christina, Heidi, and Nathan; and sister - Lois Mallick of Moorhead.
