Everett (Ev) Ray Dahlvang of Wadena, MN passed from this life at age 42 on Thursday, July 28, 2011 in Cass County, MN. Ev was born in St. Louis Park, MN, on November 6, 1968 to Dennis and Marlys (McGregor) Dahlvang. Ev spent much of his childhood in Spearfish, SD, but considered central Minnesota his home. On December 18, 2000 he married Linda. They were soulmates from the start. He loved his family deeply. They could all count on him to be there when they needed him. He was their rock. He carried tracts with him at all times, and put them in restrooms, phone booths, magazine racks and anywhere else they might get noticed and read.
