June 9, 1916 - January 13, 2005

Florence Rosella Schenck was born to her parents Ralph and Sadie (DeWandler) Schenck on June 9, 1916 in Pillsbury, North Dakota. She passed away on Thursday, January 13th at her home surrounded by her children. Florence was a high school basketball star in Pillsbury until she contracted polio which she survived following a two year fight. Because of her illness and the need for her to help her family she was not able to continue her high school career. Florence was united in marriage to William Howard Shiflett in 1935. They lived in the New York Mills area before moving to Oak Valley Township near Deer Creek, and then to their present farm just outside of Deer Creek. She enjoyed helping on the farm with raising chickens, ducks, selling pickles to the pickle factory and the farm life. She and her husband Howard were instrumental in starting the Silver Spur Saddle Club in Wadena. Florence had a lifelong love of horses. She was also an avid gardener, loved quilting, baking and raising flowers. Following Howards death she enjoyed her time spent with her son and daughter in law in Indiana, traveling the country with them. Florence was preceded in death by her husband Howard on May 2, 1995. She was also preceded in death by her mother, her step-father Guy Sharp and a sister Laverne Taylor. Florence is survived by her son Bill (Betty) of Peru, Indiana; daughter Carol of Deer Creek; grandchildren Sherye of Wadena, Jody of Deer Creek, Brian of Peru, Indiana & Rick of Des Moines, IA; 7 great-grandchildren; sisters Burnadean Walen of Detroit Lakes, MN and Mary Lou Woolridge of Anchorage, Alaska. Funeral services will be Tuesday,

January 18th at 1:00 PM in the Salem United Methodist Church in Deer Creek with the Rev. Alan Anderson and Rev. Allen Fultz officiating. Burial will take place next to husband Howard in the Inman Cemetery of rural Deer Creek.
