Frances S. Hanson was born on September 14, 1920 to Dirk and Fanne (Claassen) Stindt at Buffalo Center, Iowa. Frances passed away at Tri-County Hospital in Wadena early Wednesday morning, May 16, at 86 years of age. Frances has lived in this area for the past 48 years, most recently at the Fair Oaks Apartments in Wadena. Frances married Maynard S. Hanson on March 8, 1946 at Buffalo Center. Maynard preceded her in death in 1981. Frances worked for a variety of businesses throughout her career including as a social editor for the local newspaper.
