George Edward Daniels, 74, went to his rest on Tuesday, January 17, 2006, in his home, surrounded by the love and care of his family. George was born to Louis and Julia (Cizek) Daniels on October 23, 1931, in Germana Township near Bertha, MN. He attended a one-room country schoolhouse in Todd County, and later attended agricultural school in Staples, MN. In 1951, George married Delores Wassom. They had two daughters: Denise of Vernon Center, MN, and Lila of Duluth, MN. George had many careers in his lifetime, including being a farmer, sawmill owner, carpenter, and small business owner. He was helpful to family, friends, and neighbors, always willing to lend a hand. A commonly heard phrase was, "Let George do it." For the past seven years, George was the maintenance man at Heritage Apartments in Gary New Duluth, MN. All the residents will miss him. George was active in the Bertha community for the many years he lived there, serving for 25 years on the ambulance crew and fire department (many years as Chief). He was also a member of the Commercial Club, Lions Club, and Development Board, and served for 11 years on the Bertha-Hewitt School Board. In addition, he served on the Germana Township Board. His parents, Louis and Julia Daniels; Delores' parents, Charles and Evelyn Wassom; and his son-in-law Larry Dolezal preceded George in death. He is survived by Delores, his wife of 54 years; daughters Denise (Randy) Schwartz and Lila (Virgil) Boehland; brother Leonard Daniels; grandchildren Shana Dolezal (Kim Davis), Andrea Boehland (Duane Allen), Jessica Boehland, Jamie Dolezal (Jennifer Storry), Bobbie
