March 18, 1910 - February 25, 2009

Funeral services for George Erickson were held at 11:00 AM on Monday, March 2, 2009 at the Faith Lutheran Church in Eagle Bend with Reverend Cordell Strug and Reverend Mary Carol Strug presiding. George passed away on February 25, 2009 at the age of 98 years, at the Central Todd County Care Center in Clarissa. He served honorably in the United States Army during World War II from 1942 –1945. He was united in marriage with Irene Farrell on August 18, 1947. As a farmer in the Eagle Bend, MN area his hobbies included working with horses, “wheeling and dealing”, coffee time with family and friends, and savoring chocolate. He was a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars. George was preceded in death by his parents, Peter and Lucy; son Roger Farrell; brothers, William, Phillip, Elmer, and James; and sisters, Mae Robinson, and Alice Campbell.
