



Gladys Sagehorn

November 25, 1923 - February 15, 2017

The funeral service for Gladys Sagehorn of Bertha will be held at 1:00 p.m. on Sunday, February 19, at the Domian-Anderson Chapel in Bertha. Visitation will be held at the Chapel on Sunday from 11:00 a.m. until the time of service. Gladys, age 93, passed away February 15, 2017, peacefully at home in Bertha, MN.

Gladys was born to William and Bessie (Hofmann) Schmidt on November 11, 1923, in Belgrade, MN. She lived on the farm in Bertha for many years with husband Melvin before selling the farm and moving into town. Gladys had graduated from St. Cloud State University and was a business teacher at Bertha High School for 29 years. She touched many people's lives as a teacher, as a member of the senior center, as a member of the Faith United Church of Christ, the American Legion Auxiliary Guild, and the retired teacher's club. For many years Gladys participated as an election judge.

Gladys played piano for the church and played cards (whist, bridge, pinochle, cribbage, and solitaire) with her card groups and family. She loved to walk, read books, watch the Twins games, go on boat rides in Wisconsin, travel and spend time with friends and family.

Gladys was preceded in death by parents William and Bessie, husband Melvin Sagehorn, and son Scott Sagehorn. She is survived by sons Dick

(Sandy) Sagehorn from Maple Grove, MN and Curt (Lori) Sagehorn from St Michael, MN; grandchildren Tara, Chad, Kari, Reid, Drew, Morgan, Sydney, and Holly; great-grandchildren Hugh, Blake, Thomas, Nora, and Jaxon; and other nieces and nephews and relatives.

Burial will be in Peace Evangelical Cemetery, Bertha, MN.

Lunch will be at the Faith United Church of Christ in Bertha following the burial.
