June 19, 1926 - March 31, 2007

Grace Florence Ludovissie, age 80 of Wadena, passed away quietly from cancer on Saturday, March 31st at the Fair Oaks Lodge in Wadena. Grace was born on June 19, 1926 on the family farm in Ward Township of Todd County to her parents John & Emma (Sadlo) Kveton. She went to grade school at Dist. 132 and graduated from Clarissa High School. She worked for 4 years at Munsingware in the Twin Cities prior to her marriage. On January 25, 1949 she was united in marriage to John Thomas Ludovissie at St. Peter's Catholic Church in Browerville. After her children were grown she began working as a home health aid for the Wadena County Public Health Department. Her family was a very important part of her life.
