May 9, 1909 - June 2, 2010

Harold William Bendix was born to John and Anna (Groth) Bendix on May 9, 1909, in Echo, MN. He attended grade school through 8th grade in Inman Township, and graduated from Northwest School of Agriculture in Crookston. Harold was united in marriage with Agnes V. Lorine on May 15, 1937 in Wadena. His livelihood was in farming, and he enjoyed gardening and driving tractor for his son. He served as Compton Township Supervisor for 32 years. He was a member of Messiah Lutheran Church, serving on the Church Board, and the District 94 School Board for Compton Township. Harold passed away on June 2, 2010, at the age of 101, at Tri-County Hospital in Wadena. He was preceded in death by his wife, Agnes, on July 18, 1999; his parents John and Anna; brothers, Gay, Harvey, and Virgil; and sisters Norma, Esther, Doretta, and Bernadeen. He is survived by sons Harris (Shirley) of Wadena, and David (Marie) of Deer Creek; daughter Sandra (James) Maloney of Deer Creek; 7 grandchildren, 18 great-grandchildren, and 2 great-great-grandchildren; sister Bernice Dupree of Hamel; and many nieces and nephews. Funeral services were held at 1:30 p.m. on Sunday, June 6, 2010 at the Messiah Lutheran Church in Wadena, with Pastor Del Moen officiating.
