



## Harry Hendershot

June 19, 1915 - January 14, 2006

Funeral services for Harry Hendershot, age 90 of rural Parkers Prairie, will be held at 2:00 PM on Wednesday, January 18, 2006, at the Domian-Anderson Funeral Home in Bertha led by Marvin "Pat" Johnson. Harry passed away at his home on Saturday, January 14, 2006. Harry Leonard Hendershot was born on June 19, 1915 in Hewitt to David "Jack" and Mary (Jenson) Hendershot. He farmed with his father before entering the Army on March 6, 1942. He was a Purple Heart recipient for wounds sustained in 1944. He was discharged on October 8, 1945 after having honorably served in Normandy, northern France, Rhineland, Ardennes and central Europe. On September 5, 1951, Harry married Marjorie Blake. He farmed in Elmo Township from 1952 until the present and worked for the Soo Line Railroad from 1968 until 1983. He enjoyed hunting and fishing as well as farming and going to auction sales. Harry was preceded in death by his wife Marjorie on June 25, 1988; his parents Jack and Mary; brothers Warren and Elmer; and sisters Bernice Fink and Florence Hennagir. He is survived by his daughter Rebecca (Doug) Grant of Erhard, MN and sons Steve (Annette) Hendershot, Dareld Hendershot and Dale Hendershot, all of Parkers Prairie; 9 grandchildren and 5 great-grandchildren; and brother Ervin (Myrtle) Hendershot of Parkers Prairie.
