



Helen Leone Snyder

March 27, 1918 - September 9, 2015

The memorial service for Helen Leone Snyder, a resident of Fair Oaks Lodge in Wadena, will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Wednesday, September 16, at the Verndale Chapel. Visitation will be at the chapel from 9:30 a.m. until the time of service. At the age of 97, Helen passed away on Wednesday, September 9, 2015, at the Fair Oaks Lodge in Wadena.

Helen was born March 27, 1918, to Clarence "Harold" and Lilly (Robinson) Campbell in Wadena, MN. She was the eldest of five children.

Helen met a young man named Orval Keith "Mike" Snyder who loved to dance as much as she did. Mike and Helen were married on January 12, 1941. They rented a farm near Bluegrass and later managed a dairy farm by Sebeka before buying a farm near Verndale. Mike and Helen loved to entertain and also enjoyed hosting card parties.

Helen always had a garden and a pantry in her basement filled with items she had canned. She was best known for her interior decorating skills. She loved to wallpaper her home as well as her friends' homes. She had great taste in decorations and furnishings, including an eye for contrast. Mike often joked he had bruises from running into furniture that had been moved.

Helen is survived by her sons, Tony (Shirley) Snyder of Kingman, AZ, and

Stanley (Linda) Snyder of Pillager, MN; two grandchildren, Cindy (Dave) Bjorneberg of Hansen, ID, and Brian Snyder of Minneapolis, MN; three great-grandchildren, Mari and Matthew Bjorneberg and Ava Snyder; her sister, Myra Campbell of Huntington Beach, CA; numerous nieces and nephews; along with a special friend Marilyn Baker of Verndale.

She was preceded in death by her husband Mike Snyder, parents Harold and Lilly Campbell, and three siblings: Don Campbell, Ida M. Erickson and Cora Alvewhere.

Burial will be in the Greenlawn Cemetery, Verndale, MN.
