Funeral services for Herbert Milton Johnson of Hewitt and formerly of rural Aldrich were held at 11:00 AM on Wednesday, November 2, 2011 at the Balsamlund Lutheran Church, rural Aldrich, with Pastor Del Moen presiding. Herb passed away at the age of 88 years on Saturday, October 29, 2011 at the Tri County Hospital in Wadena. Herb was born on July 9, 1923 to Fred J. and Ida Evelyn (Westberg) Johnson at their home in Bartlett Township. He graduated high school and spent his lifetime in Bartlett Township as a dairy farmer.
