



## Homer Pooler

December 8, 1929 - July 5, 2006

Homer Pooler, age 76 of Eagle Bend, MN, passed away on Wednesday, July 5th at the St. William's Living Center in Parkers Prairie. Homer Boyd Pooler was born on December 8, 1929 at the home of his parents, Lester and Hattie (Davis) Pooler, in Burleene Township, Todd County. He served his country in the US Army during the Korean War entering in 1952. He received a Combat Infantry Badge, Korean Service Ribbon with 1 Bronze Service Star, a National Defense Service Medal, a United Nations Service Medal, and was honorably discharged in 1954. Homer married Beverly Christensen on November 20, 1955 in the Reynolds Church at Gutches Grove located in rural Todd County. He worked as a well- driller in Alaska before working 22 years at Eagle Bend Produce. He and Beverly purchased the farm in Burleene Township in 1961. They separated in 1999. When not working, he enjoyed camping, dancing and playing cards. Homer was preceded in death by his parents Lester and Hattie; infant daughter; and brothers Marvin, Miles, Clyde, Wesley and Richard.
