The funeral for Irene Grewing will be held on Thursday, September 13th, 2012, at 11:00 AM at S. John Lutheran Church in Wadena, MN. Mrs. Irene Grewing passed away quietly in her sleep on Saturday, September 8, 2012, at the Lakewood Health Center in Staples, MN where she resided. Irene was 90 years old and had recently celebrated her birthday. Her Celebration of Life was attended by her children, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, her step-sister Wilma and many friends. Irene Marie Grewing (June) was born on August 4, 1922, in Crown Point, IN, to Glenn and Wilhemina June. She had 3 older brothers, Garwyn, Glenn, and Benjamin. The young family moved to Nimrod, MN. After the loss of her mother, Irene's father re-married and an additional 3 step-siblings, Ruth, Wilma and Walter became part of the family. Irene June married Clifford Grewing on June 6, 1940. She participated in a women's bowling league and was an avid fan of the Minnesota Twins baseball team. Irene was an excellent cook and loved to bake bread and pies to the delight of her family.
