As the disease advanced, he continued to enjoy outings like going out for dinner or car rides (especially if it was to get ice cream), or quiet time spent just sitting together.

He will be greatly missed by all of us. He was a wonderful father, Papa, husband, brother, uncle and friend. While we feel sadness at our tremendous loss, there's also peace and comfort knowing he is surrounded by his heavenly family and friends, and is no longer suffering. His examples of generosity, support, love and humor will remain in our hearts forever.
