Jean (Hammond) Johnson, born February 8th, 1920 in Saint Cloud Minnesota, daughter of Edward and Della Hammond, died in Henderson, Nevada on March 8th, 2015. The third of four daughters.

Jean was a Tech High graduate who went on to complete her bachelor's degree in English and music from Saint Cloud Teachers College. She taught at Parkers Prairie before moving to Wadena where she met her husband Warren Johnson whom she married in 1944. During a long and healthy life they lived in Minnetonka, Minnesota (1954-77) and retired spending summers at Ottertail Lake and winters in the Rio Grand Valley, southern Texas. Returning to Wadena Jean remained an active contributor to her community, playing organ and piano for more than seventy years, offering her talents to church groups in McAllen, Texas and Minnetonka, Minnesota at Excelsior UCC. In 2011 Jean moved to southern Nevada to join her daughter Jennifer.

She is survived; by her sister Pat Campbell residing in Osseo, Minnesota and Green Valley Arizona and her daughter Jennifer Johnson and granddaughter Savannah La Vergne in Henderson, Nevada, and grandson Eric Johnson in

Portland, Oregon as well as many nieces and nephews.
