



## Jean Layman

The funeral service for Jean Marthella Layman, of Perham and formerly of New York Mills and Deer Creek, will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, August 6, at Schuller Family Funeral Home's Johnson-Schuller Chapel in Wadena with Rev. Jean, age 91, passed away with family at her side on Thursday, August 1, 2019, at the Hadley House in Perham MN Under the gentle care of Hospice of the Red River Valley.

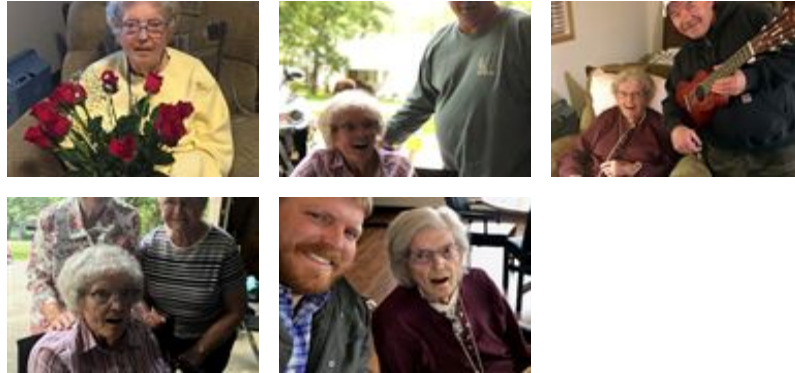

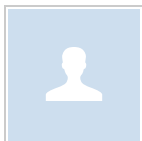
