Jeanette Hansen, age 85 and former teacher, passed away at her home in Eagle Bend. Jeanette Johanna Hansen was born in Bertha on October 23, 1919 to Joseph and Alma (Steinkraus) Lind. Jeanette was united in marriage with Harold Marin Hansen in May of 1941 at Belvidere, Illinois. After graduating from high school in June of 1937, she received her teaching degree from St. Cloud Teacher's College and began teaching in the rural school system. She eventually found herself teaching at the Eagle Bend School from where she retired. She was a member of the Region 5 Task Force, the Teachers Retirement Association and the Eagle Bend City Council. She was also a sponsor for Future Teacher's of America & SAE. In her spare time she enjoyed reading and bird-watching as well as expressing her artistic side through her gardening, painting, and pottery. Jeanette was preceded in death by her husband, Harold, on February 5, 1972; parents Joseph and Alma; brothers Deward, Harold, Raymond and Jack (Vivian); sisters Lillian, Leva, Dorris, Beatrice and Ruth; and niece Betty Helgeson. She is survived by her children Renee and Leonard Nack of Newcastle, WY, Curt and Bonnie Hansen of Roosevelt, MN and Marin and Jeanette Hansen of Eagle Bend, MN; 9 grandchildren and 13 great-grandchildren.
