Memorial services for Jeanette Hilda Johnson, a resident of the Lakewood Health Systems Care Center and formerly of Staples and rural Bertha, were held at 10:30 AM on Saturday, August 20, 2011 at the Domian-Anderson Funeral Home in Bertha with Pastor Marli Danielson presiding. Jeanette passed away at the age of 85 on Sunday, August 14, 2011 at the care center in Staples. Jeanette was born on July 21, 1926 at Clara City, MN to Habbe F. and Arianna A. (Janssen) Cornelius.
